



Local Official Scholarships For the 2026 ASFPM Conference



May 31 – June 4, 2026
Location: Milwaukee, Wisconsin

If you've been wanting to attend the premiere floodplain management conference in the US, here's your opportunity to maximize your training and travel funds by taking advantage of a scholarship to attend the Association of State Floodplain Managers (ASFPM) annual conference. The Maryland Association of Floodplain and Stormwater Managers (MAFSM) is sponsoring up to three in-person full registrations to the ASFPM conference for Maryland public sector-employed floodplain and stormwater management professionals. The conference is a great opportunity to share experiences, build relationships, and learn from other floodplain management professionals. CFMs can earn CEC credits through numerous presentations and workshops presented throughout the week. Scholarship is intended to supplement local government reimbursement funds, and travel reimbursement for the conference is available up to \$1000.

Application Requirements:

1. MAFSM members only. Membership required prior to application submittal.
2. Scholarships are only available to Maryland public sector-employed floodplain and SWM professionals
3. Provide a brief, digital request letter to the representative below, including:
 - A. Brief description of the benefit you see to attending this conference.
 - B. Your local official position.
 - C. Make note if you have previously presented at a MAFSM conference or are planning to present at ASFPM.
 - D. If you are a new floodplain manager, a first-time attendee to the ASFPM conference, or have previously received a scholarship for conference attendance from MAFSM.
 - E. Provide brief letter of support from your leadership to attend the conference, indicating understanding of costs covered by this scholarship

Request deadline for letters of application is March 1, 2026. The recipients will be notified with instructions to submit registration forms by the Early Bird Registration Deadline for the conference, April 15, 2026.

In an effort to further representation of the Maryland ASFPM chapter at the conference, MAFSM asks awardees to participate in at least one ASFPM chapter event, such as attending the Foundation dinner or chapter meeting. This is another great opportunity to network and collaborate with other ASFPM chapter groups.
